Be prepared for potential hurricane dangers - Know Your Risk, Get Prepared and Stay Informed

There are 3 main components to being hurricane prepared - **know your risk, get prepared, and stay informed.**

Each year hurricanes cause devastating impacts. Hurricanes are not just a threat to coastal communities. As North Carolina has witnessed in the past, hurricanes, wind and water can cause damage statewide. High winds, heavy rainfall, tornadoes, and flooding can be felt hundreds of miles inland, potentially causing loss of life and catastrophic damage to property. As past experience has shown us, it is not only major hurricanes (Category 3 or higher) to worry about, but *all* hurricanes can cause significant damage.

DCDEE is committed to ensuring the safety of children and child care providers and is calling on programs to prepare with us. **Knowing your risk, getting prepared, and staying informed** are the primary steps you should take to get ready for impending storms and all of hurricane season.
