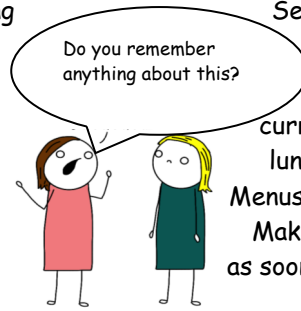

Print point-of-service ahead of time....Pour and serve milk in the correct cup sizes in order to have the required amounts...Submit paperwork after making sure it is complete...

Enter information at least weekly... Smile and remember it is worth it... Making sure everything is available for visits. Someone on-site must have access to the necessary paperwork... Check your Minute Menu messages...Thank you for all that you do



Send in all receipts....Contact Brianne or Nancy with any questions..... Complete the point-of-service when the meals are served.... Keep enrollments current...Fish sticks are not to be served at lunch or dinner...Menus must be current and posted... Menus must match what is being purchased and served... Make sure mailed items are put in your notebook as soon as received... All required paperwork must be kept on file for three years

The following are things that will cause a delay in the processing of your claim.

1. Forgetting to click the submit button.
2. Enrollments that are incomplete. Please make sure ALL information is filled in before you submit enrollments. Missing social digits, complete addresses, income, household members, etc... This causes a delay in the verification of the enrollments, which could cause disallowances for those children when processing claims.
3. Missing receipts or receipts copied with no dates.

### \*\*IMPORTANT INFORMATION\*\*

Beginning with your May Claim paperwork, it will be necessary for you to send in a copy of the DCDEE Infant Feeding Schedules for any enrolled infants. This is in preparation for the upcoming October 1, 2017 rule change regarding the new infant meal pattern. It will be changing from the three current age groups (0-3; 4-7; and 8-11 months). The new age groups will consist of only two (0-5; and 6-11 months). The Infant Feeding Schedules will help determine when the child is "developmentally ready" for infant cereals and baby food.

If you have children who drink a soy or lactose free milk substitute at their parent's request, please complete the attached form and have the parent sign. This form is different from the medical form for non-approved dairy substitutes. Return this form to Brianne or Nancy.

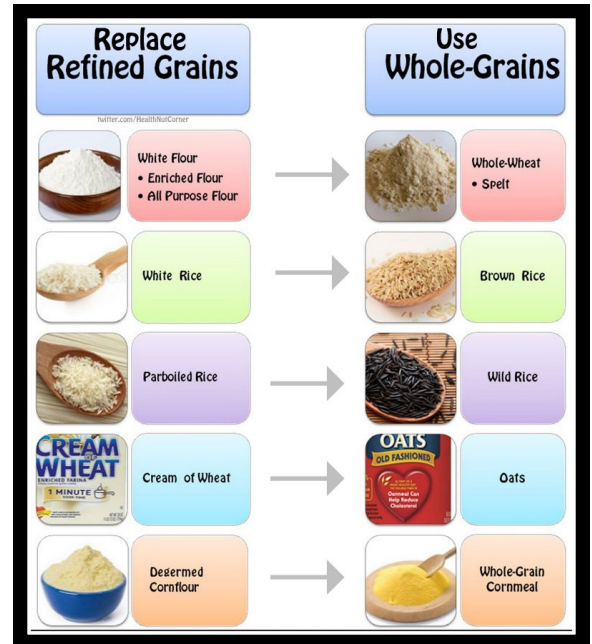


## BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2017

Juice will be limited to serving only once during the entire business day, regardless of the number of shifts. Juice for infants (children under 1 year of age) will be disallowed.



A Whole Grain food item must be served for at least one meal or snack during the entire business day, regardless of the number of shifts. The first ingredient for other breads/grains served must still be whole, or enriched flour. Only one meal or snack a day must include a Whole Grain food item.



CACFP enrollments need to be completed when children enroll in the center. Expiring enrollments must be renewed by the expiration date. Meals for children with enrollments that are found to be missing or expired during monitoring visits will be disallowed until a valid enrollment has been verified at our office.

Also, when a child who has previously withdrawn returns, please reactivate child from 'withdrawn' tab, instead of re-entering as a 'new' child.

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
